## **Meeting 1**

### **What is the Kingdom of God?**

#### **I. The Kingdom of God**

**The Kingdom of God is when and where God's rule, authority, lordship, and power is manifested.**

##### **Key verses:**

Psalm 103:19 The Lord has established His throne in heaven, And His kingdom rules over all.

Psalm 47:2 For the Lord Most High is awesome; He is a great King over all the earth.

Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

Matthew 6:9-10a In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. ...

Revelation 22:3-5 And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him. They shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads. There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever.

#### **II. Are you in God's Kingdom?**

##### **Key verses:**

1 Thessalonians 2:12 that you would walk worthy of God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.

Colossians 1:13-14 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

John 3:3-5 Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?"

Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

### **III. How can you grow in God's Kingdom?**

#### **Key verses:**

Matthew 6:33a But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness,

2 Peter 1:10-11 Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble

Matthew 5:11-12 "Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you."

Romans 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

- How can you experience the joy of being in God's Kingdom today?



## **Meeting 2**

### **Living Waters: Jesus Calls Us to Himself**

#### **Key verses:**

John 4:10 “If you only knew the gift God has for you and who you are speaking to, you would ask Me, and I would give you living water.”

John 4:42 “Now we believe, not just because of what you told us, but because we have heard Him ourselves. Now we know that He is indeed the Savior of the world.”

#### **Questions (Youths)**

1. What fills your life today?
2. Does it satisfy you fully?
3. Do you believe that Jesus can satisfy all your needs/quench your thirst?

#### **Questions (Young People)**

1. Do you give God the true worship in your life?
2. How can you continue to seek this living water?

#### **Questions (Cornerstone)**

1. Who is Jesus to you?
2. What is God’s gift to you?
3. Are you confident in sharing your story of salvation with others?



## Meeting 3

### The Zealousness of James & John

#### Key verses:

Luke 9:56 For the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives but to save them." And they went to another village.

Matthew 20:25-28:

But Jesus called them to Himself and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and those who are great exercise authority over them. Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant. And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave—just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

#### Questions

1. Why is it important that the Samaritan village is not destroyed? Read Acts 1:8, 8:4-8, Ezekiel 33:11 and share the outcome of the Samaritan village being allowed to live.
2. What does it mean to be a servant leader? Does Jesus mean we should do everything for those we are leading? If not, what do you think He means?
3. As you grow and learn from Christ, have you found that you are being transformed by God into spiritual maturity just like James and John? Share your personal experiences if any.

### Peter's Transformation: From Denial to Declaration

#### I. Denial, Reconciliation, and Restoration

Peter's Denial (John 18:15-27)

Peter's Reconciliation (John 21:1-14)

Peter's Restoration (John 21:15-19)

#### II. Transformation

##### Key verses:

Acts 1:4-5,8 "And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me; for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

"You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Ephesians 1:13-14 "In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory."

Ephesians 5:18 And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit.



**Reflection:**

- What holds us back from speaking boldly about our faith?
- What could “giving Jesus” look like in our lives today?
- How do you respond when your faith is challenged?
- Do you feel the Holy Spirit in you?



## Meeting 5

### At Jesus' feet... our better portion, our reasonable service

#### Key Verses

Luke 10:38-42

As Jesus and his disciples were on their way, he came to a village where a woman named Martha opened her home to him. She had a sister called Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet listening to what he said. But Martha was distracted by all the preparations that had to be made. She came to him and asked, "Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do the work by myself? Tell her to help me!" "Martha, Martha," the Lord answered, "you are worried and upset about many things, but few things are needed—or indeed only one. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her."

#### Questions (Youths)

From Luke 10:38-42

1. Describe what was Mary and Martha focusing on.
2. What might Martha have missed in her area of focus?
3. How have you been distracted from Jesus?

From John 12:1-5, Matthew 26:8-13

4. Describe Mary's offering, and the responses from the disciples and Jesus.
5. From Jesus' response, what did the disciples miss out on?
6. How might you be missing out Jesus in your everyday living?

## Questions (Cornerstone)

From Luke 10:38-42

1. Compare and describe differences between Mary and Martha's service.
2. What have you learnt from Jesus' response to Martha?
3. In what ways have you served like Mary or Martha?

From John 12:1-5, Matt 26:8-13

4. Describe Mary's offering and what impressed you about it.
5. What does this passage reveal about:
  - What is in Mary's heart?
  - What is in the disciples' hearts?
6. How does this passage speak to you about your heart, and service towards Jesus?

### I. Martha's approach

What did Martha do? What did Martha missed?

How have you been like Martha?

Service that comes from self and works takes attention away from Jesus.

### II. Mary's approach

What did Mary do? What did Mary enjoy?

How does this passage speak to you about your focus and priorities in life?

Service that comes from obedience to Jesus brings rest, joy & satisfaction.

### III. Mary's beautiful worship of Jesus

What impresses you about Mary's worship?

What did Mary experience that the other disciples missed?

Service that pleases Jesus comes from one's deep relationship with Him.

**Our best portion in life is to serve Jesus in love, humility & obedience**

**Reflection:**

- In what areas of your life have you missed out Jesus?
- How is Jesus calling you to enter into His rest, joy & satisfaction?
- Where have Jesus impressed upon you to worship & follow Him?
